What clubs form part of EFNL

Eastern Netball Football League is made up of 48 clubs (Junior and Senior) with 614 teams in total with 71 of these Netball Clubs. The Junior Competition consists of 39 clubs over 7 local council regions. EFNL have 48 divisions with 37 of these competitive from Under 11's to Under 19.5's. Their strong partnership with Hawthorn Football Club allows multiple interactions with this AFL club.

Will there be a new uniform?

If the change of league is successful, this will mean a change of uniform for BJFC as we are currently branded SEJ, however, EFNL allows a 3-year grace period for us to transition to EFNL branded uniforms. EFNL do not play with white shorts therefore only require the need to purchase one pair of shorts for the year.

Will my fees go up?

Every year the fee structure is discussed by the new incoming Committee for the next season. We are unable to anticipate whether a fee increase will be introduced into the 2024 Season at this stage, regardless of what league we end up in.

When does the fixture come out for the EFNL?

The full season fixture for EFNL typically comes out in February / March each year.

When does the season start?

The EFNL season begins 1 week prior to the SEJ season.

How long is the season?

EFNL seasons run for 14 rounds plus 3 weeks of finals.

EFNL - do not play the middle week of the April Holidays or the Kings Birthday weekend, however they do play on the Sunday in the middle of June School Holidays.



Are the finals the same structure and is it still just U11 and up?

Yes, EFNL have the same finals structure of only competitive age groups (U11) playing off in the Finals Series.

Do EFNL supply umpires?

Two Umpires for all U8 to U17.5 mixed/boys and U16-U18 girls, Senior umpires cross over into Juniors on Sunday.

Boundary and Goal Umpires

EFNL do not supply Boundary Umpires for any of their games. They use the "Last Possession" rule in their games and if required, the Field Umpires will bring the ball in 10m from the boundary and ball up. Teams are required to provide their own goal umpire for every game.

Individual Grading of Teams

In regard to EFNL, all competitive age groups are graded from U11 through to U17.5 Boys. If we are to transfer to EFNL we will consider grading our teams from U11 age group, previously we commenced from U13's.. As we only have 1 team for U12 Girls through to U18 Girls, unless there are multiple teams these teams will not be graded.

Grading of teams within EFNL Competition.

The league will send out nominations for clubs to put forward what division/grade they believe their teams should compete in for the 2024 season. This process commences in early February.

EFNL will then analyse past season results (for existing teams) and determine what division/grade the EFNL deems appropriate for each team. Clubs will then be notified of what divisions/grades they are in and then have 5 days to respond to the EFNL if they believe a team has been placed in an incorrect division/grade. Once all teams and grades are finalised the league will create a fixture for the first 4 rounds which will serve as grading games.

Once the 4 rounds are completed, grading will be done by the league and any changes will be made. EFNL will look at wins and losses (including margins) as well as which teams clubs have played when determining changes to grades.

The fixture from Rounds 5-14 is then released. Clubs with 2 teams in an age group generally start in A grade and D grade. Clubs determine who plays in each team.

Playing Up

Players can play up an age group if registered to that team.

EFNL Ladders

EFNL does not include percentages on their ladders as they use a win/loss ratio formula instead.

Assisting sides in the same age division

Once a child has played 5 games in a higher division side, they cannot play in the lower division side again. Lower division players can help the higher division teams though out the season.

If BJFC move or stay? Will there be an U16s age group?



There is an U16 competition within the EFNL and U16 will remain for SEJ for next season.

Travel Times

Below is a summary of estimated travel times as we know that travel can make a big difference to how Game Day plays out for our families. It is important to note that **7** games of the season will be away games and **7** local home games.

AFLSE have advised they are in discussion with MPJFL, how will this effect BJFC?

AFLSE confirmed they are in talks with the Mornington Peninsula Junior Football League (MPJFL) that would see them join the regional competition along with the FDJFL and SEJFL.

The regional competition is played in age groups u15s and above in 2024 Season.

U13 and U14's will join part of the regional competition in 2025.

Will fees be reduced to compensate the extra kilometres we will have to travel to games?

No, we will still be expected to cover the same amount of expenses as being in the SEJ/AFLSE. It should be highlighted that out of the 14 games, 7 are played locally. If the other two SEJ/AFLSE clubs are also successful with their transfer to SEJ/ALFSE and are potentially in the same division, this will make 9 games out of 14 played locally.

Interleague

EFNL field the following squads in the Victorian Metro Development Series.

- 2 x u14 Boys
- 2 x u15 Girls
- 2 x u15 Boys

All the 7 Victorian Metro Leagues only do the same age groups (U14 and 1U5) as they are feeders to Coates League.

Coates League begins in Under 16s with the futures program.

Unlike SEJ the EFNL do not have interleague teams for U16, U17.5 or U18 girls. This is because players from these age groups have already been identified and are already at the Coates League future program.

EFNL has partnered with Project Gap who provide high performance support throughout the program. EFNL also has a partnership with the Hawthorn FC for our representative program which allows unique opportunities for players involved.

The series is played over 3 games:

- Wednesday Night late May
- Saturday Kings Birthday
- Monday Kings Birthday



U8 Competition

There is a complete change to the way AFLSE and EFNL structure their U8 competition. EFNL organises these age groups into hubs so that there is less travel for families. The under 8s competition is played at a central venue each week, if BJFC were to join the under 8 competition this would be held at Rowville.

Eg/ Fixture - BJFC vs Rowville U8s - you would play two 9 a side games side by side on a modified ground size.

U9 and U10 Competition

Under 9s

A team consists of 18 players. This team is then split into two and forms two 9 a side games.

Eg/ Fixture - BJFC vs Rowville U9s - you would play two 9 a side games side by side on a modified ground size.)

- Ground Size Small Oval 75m Long v 50m Wide
- No bouncing ball
- No tackling, barging, stripping, stealing ball
- No Scoring
- No kicking off ground
- Qtr Length 10min

Last three rounds of season we revert to 18 a side, full ground and stand tackles to prepare for Under 10s the following season.

Under 10s

A team consists of 18 players and played on a full ground (where appropriate). There is no zoning in U10's and EFNL Umpires are supplied.

Player Transfer Points

Currently in SEJ a team can only have 10 player transfer points however EFNL do not utilise a player transfer points system.
